



Game Format



Game	Players	Description / Scoring
Ambrose	Teams of 2	<p>Stroke play with team handicaps combined together, divided by 4 and deducted from total gross scores. Each player hits off the tee, the best shot is selected with the other player picking up their ball and place it, within one handspan, alongside the best ball. Each person then hits a second shot from the same spot. The best shot is again selected. This continues until the ball is in the hole. On the putting green the best ball is marked and the other balls are played from this position. Each player must have 6 drives each selected.</p>
Canadian Foursomes Stableford	Teams of 2	<p>Stableford Foursomes alternate shot. Both players tee off then alternate shots are hit.</p>

ALGC Local Rules



What to know before teeing off...

- Please check 'CONDITIONS OF PLAY' for any changes to local rules.
- Pond at 3rd/12th hole to be treated as YELLOW STAKED WATER HAZARD. As a local rule you may play provisional ball from the tee if unsure ball has entered hazard. If your ball has gone into the pond, your second shot must be taken behind the pond, with point of entry between you and the hole, not from the sides.
- A ball lying on any closely mown area may be marked, lifted, cleaned and placed within 15cm of the original spot no nearer the hole.
- All unmarked drains are to be treated as part of the fairways, as they are unmown, there is NO RELIEF.
- Concrete drain near 1st green and 2nd fairway, treat as a free drop when ball lies on CONCRETE only – one club length at nearest point of relief.
- The irrigation trench itself and any part of the course behind the trench, above the 8th and 17th greens, to be treated as OUT OF BOUNDS.
- Always KEEP UP WITH THE FIELD. If you have lost a ball and players are waiting, wave them through.
- Three minutes is the time allowed to look for lost ball.
- Mark cards AFTER you have hit off.
- Do not wait for everyone else to hit before walking to your ball. Be ready to hit when it is your turn and always take your buggy up to your ball. At the green, place buggy behind the green. If ready, tee off. Don't wait on others.
- SLOW PLAY IS NOT CONSIDERATE PLAY. After two warnings members will receive a penalty of 2 strokes.
- INGROUND RED markers will be used to tee off for all events.
- NO MOBILE PHONES to be used whilst on the golf course except for using MiScore, in the case of an emergency and for checking rules.

TO ENSURE A PLEASANT GAME OF GOLF FOR ALL.

Notices and handy reminders

- There is a ball jackpot on the first hole for first shot being within one putter handle length from the pin. Jackpot applies only to individual competition events in the current year. The jackpot will accumulate (Max 6 balls) from the first individual competition event of the season until claimed by the winner. Once claimed, the ball jackpot will revert to zero and continue to accumulate (maximum 6 balls).
- When entering "Knockout" competitions, you will need to be available for the next rounds. Forfeiture is only acceptable under extreme circumstances.
- Current handicap applies for all events.
- For all ALGC events, if there are less than 4 players, there will be no competition for the day.
- Golf NSW medals, Avalon medals and Club Championships which end in a tie will be decided by countback.
- In all competitions played under Golf NSW conditions, objections or queries raised by players should be lodged with a member of the Match Committee.
- Alterations may be made in the programme at the discretion of the Match Committee.
- Committee members responsible for competition results at the end of play and on the media website.

Quick notes from the Committee

- Please contact Jan Biggs, Katrina Murray or Sherryn Williams if UNABLE to play on the day prior to Tee off and have not been able to de-register via the members portal.
- Arrive 15 minutes before tee time
- Keep pace with the field
- 3 minutes max to search for lost balls.
- Update MiScore / cards after putting out.
- Use red markers for all events.
- Mobile phones only to be used for electronic scoring, checking rules and for emergencies.
- Slow play = 2-stroke penalty after two warnings.
- NSNA - No Score Not Approved status will be entered into MiClub / Golf Link for players that do not complete the minimum number of holes for a valid competition round and do not provide a valid reason. If you have concerns re completing the round upon entering, seek advice from Jan Biggs, Sherryn Williams or Katrina Murray.
- NSA - No Score Approved status will be entered for players into MiClub / Golf Link that do not complete the minimum number of holes for a valid competition round and have provided a valid reason to the Competition Administrator (which meets the Golf Australia competition guidelines). This score will appear as an entry on a players handicap record without influencing their handicap status.
- Respect pace of play and course care
- Celebrate each other's wins — big or small!
